CHILDREN AND YOUTH

Nursery care is provided for infants through 4 years of age. The nursery may be reached either through the Parish Hall or the back hall of the Education Building.

Children's Chapel is provided during the 9:15 service for ages 3-12. If you would like your child to participate, have him or her follow the adult leader who will be at the end of the procession during the opening hymn. Children will return to you in church at the sign of the peace.

Sunday School is held during the "school year" between the 9:15 and 11:30 services and is provided for children 3 years through high school.

- 6-12th graders meet in the EYC room, in the basement.
