



2017-2018 Meet the Teacher Schedule September 1, 2017

Please join us for this year's Meet the Teacher event. Each teacher will spend a few minutes going over classroom specific guidelines and practices as well as be available to answer questions and interact with the children. Each classroom's Meet the Teacher will last 30 minutes. This keeps children from becoming overwhelmed by all the new faces and too many grown-ups in the room at one time. It also allows parents who have multiple children to visit with each child's classroom without them over-lapping.

During Meet the Teacher, we will have tables set up to collect your paperwork (see list below), visit with the school nurse, enroll in enrichment classes, purchase Stay & Play and/or MDO punch cards, and more. We will also have Gypsy Scoops here keeping us cool in the late summer heat! Gypsy Scoops offers 12 hand-dipped flavors of homemade ice-cream served cup or cone for \$3.50 per person.

Meet the Teacher times:

- Bridge class and ALL Four year old classes: 9:30-10am
- Monday/Wednesday Toddler and Two year old classes: 10-10:30am
- All Three year old classes: 10:30-11am
- Tuesday/Thursday Toddler and Two year old classes: 11-11:30am

Required Paperwork (must be turned in by Meet the Teacher)

- **2017/2018 Enrollment form-** This form has basic contact information and medical/vaccination information. It must be updated every year. Children four years and older must have a hearing/vision screen completed. Trinity requires all children be vaccinated and does **not** accept a vaccination waver except in cases of a medical issue. **This form does require a physician signature.**
- **2017/2018 Medical Action Form-** This two sided form is **ONLY** for students with a medical need that must be communicated to the school (ex) food allergies and asthma. This form **MUST** be **signed by a physician** as well as the parent.

So, now I bet you are wondering which of our AWESOME teachers your child will have... Each classroom teacher will send out a welcome postcard to the students the week prior to Meet the Teacher. This is a fun way for the children to learn their teacher's name and to help get them excited about the new school year! We do have several new staff this year and I can't wait for you to meet each of them.
