Trinity Episcopal School offers a preschool program for children who are 18 months, 2, 3, 4, and 5 years old.

Classes are small and taught by experienced teachers in a warm Christian environment. Curriculum structure and design encourages independence and development of intellectual skills, as well as the confidence of good social skills.

Students learn through center-based activities designed around age appropriate themes. Themes for toddlers, 2s and 3s include holidays, seasons, plants and animals; while the 4s journey to the seven continents exploring cultures and habitats. The five year-old curriculum is focused on a phonetic approach to reading.

Children four years and older attend chapel once a week at Trinity Episcopal Church.

Trinity Episcopal School is a wholly owned subsidiary of Trinity Episcopal Church and is licensed by the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services. T.E.S. is a member of the National and Southwestern Associations of Episcopal Schools.

Lynn Allen, Director of the school, holds a Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration and two Master's Degrees, one in Education and one in Educational Administration. Teachers are experienced and trained in early childhood education.

Trinity Episcopal School offers a Stay & Play program from 12-2pm. After school enrichment programs are offered by semester. A Friday 9am-12pm Parent's Day Out is offered in the church nursery for children eighteen months and older. The school also offers a nine week Summer Fun Program. Information about these programs is available in the school office.

Trinity Episcopal School's objectives are to help each child:

- develop autonomy as a learner
- experience comfortable and productive peer relations
- learn those basic skills and concepts necessary for intellectual development
- mature in awareness & organization of his or her environment
- grow with their individual learning style
- recognize the joy in learning.

Both the four year-old class and the bridge class provide the foundation for public or private kindergarten. The bridge class provides an additional year of preschool for children who have late birthdays or who simply want another year of preschool.

Trinity Episcopal School starts the day after Labor Day and ends the middle of May.

Children should wear closed toe shoes, and comfortable clothing that is washable and suitable for outside play. Each child brings water and lunch every day.

Parents are encouraged to help with holiday parties in the classroom through the POPS (Parents Optimizing PreSchool Organization).
