Introduction to the Spanish Language is what your child will receive when they spend time in this class. Research has shown that the best thing for a child this age is to hear a language being spoken and to try to speak the words - this develops neural pathways in the brain that can be accessed later in life when serious language study is undertaken.

This art class is open to children aged three and four who are potty trained.
